Weekend Format Protocols

- Weekend series' will be played over three consecutive days consisting of one 9-inning game Friday, two 7-inning games Saturday, and one 9-inning game Sunday.
- A series may be shifted to Saturday-Monday but must remain scheduled over three consecutive days. Decisions to shift a series should be made as early in the week as possible but must be made by Thursday at 12noon local time and require mutual consent from both institutions. Further, decisions to shift a series are subject to umpire availability.
- Games may be moved within the three-day series due to weather or other circumstances. If a series is condensed to two days: Play one 7-inning and one 9-inning game each day. If first game goes into extra innings, second game converts to a 7-inning game.
- No more than 21 innings may be played in a single day.
- A run rule will be enforced for all conference games: 9-Innings Game: 10 after 7 innings / 7-Inning Game: 12 after 5 innings

Minimum Participants

- 20 Players including a minimum of 5 pitchers for a 2-game series, 7 pitchers for a 3-game series, 9 pitchers for a 4-game series, and 1 catcher. Additionally, 1 employee of the institution to serve in a coaching capacity. Institutions can choose to participate below these thresholds but are not required to.

Minimum Game Threshold

- In order to qualify as Champion and receive the conference AQ, a team must compete a minimum of 85% of the average number of conference games played rounded up or down. .5 rounds up.
